

**The project change includes the extension of the existing Provincetown sewer collection system to include the DPW garage and Shank Painter Basin areas. Project activities include the installation of two below-grade submersible pump stations and one below-grade lift station in previously developed areas and approximately 22,000 feet of force main and gravity-fed sewer piping within existing paved roadways or along the shoulder of roadways.
