Pursuant to M.G.L. c.91, 310 CMR 9.00, M.G.L. c. 21 §43, and 33 U.S.C. 1341 notice is given of a Combined Chapter 91 Waterways License Application and 401 Water Quality Certification Application by Lynn Redevelopment, LLC to construct and maintain two (2) apartment buildings containing 332-total units with ground floor leasing space and fitness center, parking, landscaping, public open space, public waterfront walkway, and replacement of an existing shoreline protection structure with associated dredging on Filled and Flowed Tidelands of Lynn Harbor at 254 Lynnway in Lynn, Essex County.

The Department of Environmental Protection Waterways Regulation Program will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Thursday, July 19, 2018 at 3:00pm at Lynn City Hall, Meeting Room 402, 3 City Hall Square, Lynn. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License and Dredge Permit pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

Any aggrieved person, party, or group of ten (10) citizens or more, with at least five (5) of the ten (10) citizens being residents of the municipality in which the project is located, who submits written comments during the comment period may appeal the Department's 401 Certification and/or Chapter 91 License. Failure to submit written comments before the end of the public comment period may result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing.
