The proposed project is seeking approval to implement a pond dredging, aquatic nuisance vegetation removal and an invasive plant species removal and native plant species planting plan at 408 Bridge Street in Hamilton, MA. This project seeks approval under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, (M.G.L. Ch. 131 §40; and 310 CMR 10.00) by the filing of a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Hamilton Conservation Commission. The total square footage of existing bordering vegetated wetland and riverfront area will remain the same after the project, however the invasive plant community (glossy buckthorn, multiflora rose, honeysuckle, and purple loosestrife) will be removed and native species will be installed to create a viable bordering vegetated wetland habitat. A two (2) year aftercare plan is included to maintain and insure establishment of the wetland plant community at the project site.
