Innovative Technology Notice Application Submitted Pursuant to Title 5, 310 CMR 15.000 Department of Environmental Protection Wastewater Management Program Transmittal Number: X280610 Application Filing Date: July 27, 2018

Public Notice is hereby given of the application by SeptiTech/Bio-Microbics of Maine Inc. to the Department of Environmental Protection requesting **Certification for General Use** for the enhanced nitrogen removal for **SeptiTech models M400N**, **M550N**, **M750N**, **M200N**, **M1500N**, **M2500N and M3000N** pursuant to **310 CMR 15.288** of Title 5. This provision of Title 5 describes the approval process for **General Use** of innovative/ alternative technologies for the treatment and subsurface disposal of sewage from facilities regulated under Title 5.

The application proposes the use of alternative standards for the following provision in Title 5:

The **SeptiTech models M400N**, **M550N**, **M750N**, **M200N**, **M1500N**, **M2500N** and M3000N will meet or exceed the following effluent discharge requirements for facilities with design flows less than 2,000gpd:

Effluent Total Nitrogen (TN) concentration of 19 mg/l for 660 gallons per day per acre (gpda) loading OR 25 mg/l for 550 gpda loading.

The Department welcomes any interested parties to provide any relevant information concerning the performance of this technology to be considered in the review process. The Department will consider all data and written comments submitted within **21 days** after the publication of this notice in order to decide whether to grant approval pursuant to 310 CMR 15.000.
