Public Notice is hereby given of the application by Geomatrix Systems, LLC to the Department of Environmental Protection requesting **Certification for General Use** for the **SoilAir System** pursuant to **310 CMR 15.288** of Title 5. This provision of Title 5 describes the approval process for **General Use** of innovative/ alternative technologies for the treatment and subsurface disposal of sewage from facilities regulated under Title 5.

The purpose of this Certification is to allow use of the System in Massachusetts, on a General Use basis, to maintain or condition the performance of a properly functioning soil absorption System (SAS).

The Department welcomes any interested parties to provide any relevant information concerning the performance of this technology to be considered in the review process. The Department will consider all data and written comments submitted within **21 days** after the publication of this notice in order to decide whether to grant approval pursuant to 310 CMR 15.000.
