NOTICE: PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PLAN

Pursuant to the Rights-of-Way Management Regulations (333 CMR 11.00) in order to apply pesticides to control vegetation to maintain Rights-of Ways, the Department of Agricultural Resources must approve a Vegetation Management Plan (VMP) and a Yearly Operational Plan (YOP). The VMP is intended to justify the need to control vegetation, identify target vegetation, describe the intended methods of control, describe methods for identifying sensitive areas, describe operational guidelines for applicators, outline a program of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) designed to reduce the use of herbicides, and describe alternative land use activities. The following municipalities are advised that Great River Hydro proposes to utilize herbicides to treat their Rights-of-Way in Buckland, Monroe and Florida, MA.

PUBLIC HEARINGS SCHEDULED:

In accordance with 333 CMR 11.05 the Department of Agricultural Resources will conduct regional hearings to receive public comment on the proposed Vegetation Management Plan for Great River Hydro, as prepared and submitted by Wendy L. Priestly, Ph.D, Vegetation Control Service, 2342 Main St., Athol, MA 01331.

To provide all interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed VMP, public hearings will be held at the following locations:

Wednesday, May 22, 2019: Buckland Town Hall, 17 State Street, Shelburne Falls, Massachusetts from 11:00am – 12:30 pm.
