

Notice of Intent to Initiate an Ecological Restoration Project

Native Habitat Restoration LLC of Stockbridge, MA proposes to do a habitat restoration project on approximately 29,921 square feet of wetland buffer and 27,788 of riverfront area at Parsons Marsh Reserve (Berkshire Natural Resources Council) Lenox, MA. This effort is one of many successful invasive control projects overseen by Native Habitat Restoration LLC to restore native habitat that support native flora and wildlife on numerous conservation and private properties.

This proposal involves the control of nearly 20 acres of invasive hardy kiwi throughout the forest and adjacent wetlands. The centroid of the project area is at 42.370650N and -73.291322W.

It is anticipated that a Notice of Intent will be filed with the Lenox Conservation Commission on June 6, 2019.
