

In accordance with the MEPA special review conditions at 301 CMR 11.09 and the Secretary's certificate on the Final Generic Environmental Impact Report, *Eutrophication and Aquatic Plant Management in Massachusetts* (GEIR) (EOEA 0011/6934) of February 11, 2004, the following notice is provided.

On Friday, July 20, 2018 the Massachusetts Pesticide Board Subcommittee registered the following aquatic herbicide containing the active ingredient florpyrauxifen-benzyl for use in lakes and ponds:

- ProcellaCOR EC, EPA Reg. No. 67690-80

A summary of the environmental fate and toxicological characteristics of florpyrauxifen-benzyl for use was conducted by the Massachusetts Department of Agricultural Resources (MDAR) and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Office of Research and Standards. It will serve as a reference for the Departments' recommendation for use of florpyrauxifen-benzyl-based aquatic herbicides with label restrictions in lakes and ponds. The summary document will be posted on the MDAR website and will be integrated as an addendum into Appendix III of the final Generic Environmental Impact Report on Eutrophication and Aquatic Plant Management in Massachusetts.
