Re: Notification of filing a Notice of Intent and Ecological Restoration Limited Project Appendix A to Form 3 for Wildlife Habitat Management at the Tully Mountain Wildlife Management Area and property owned by Fred Heyes (Tully Mountain WCE) in Orange, MA

Notice: MassWildlife will file the Notice of Intent with the Orange Conservation Commissions and MA DEP in July 2019 or early August 2019.

Project Description: Tully Mountain WMA & WCE Habitat Project will be conducted on the Mountain Rd and Tully Rd section of the WMA and on property owned by Fred Heyes (Tully Mountain WCE, Map/Lot 210/12) on Tully Rd in Orange. The project is tailored to enhance wildlife habitat using mowing, timber harvesting, vegetation control, and prescribed fire techniques. The project qualifies as an Ecological Restoration Limited Project (ERLP), as restoring/enhancing this habitat will improve the interest of wildlife habitat, an identified interest of the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L c. 131).
