

Mass Audubon will file a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Northampton Conservation Commission in March 2020 for the Manhan Meadows Floodplain Forest Restoration Project located in Arcadia Wildlife Sanctuary, Northampton, Massachusetts. The purpose of the proposed project is to restore approximately 13 acres of former floodplain forest within the floodplain of the Connecticut River which were historically cleared and used for agricultural production. The proposed work will restore the natural capacity of the resource area to protect the interests identified in the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131 §40).
