

**MEPA Environmental Monitor Notice for Ecological Restoration Limited Project
310 CMR 10.11**

The Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will be submitting a Notice of Intent (NOI) under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act for invasive species management activities at the Beaver Brook Reservation in Waltham and Belmont, MA. Covering approximately 313 acres, Beaver Brook Reservation includes two properties, each with distinctive natural, cultural, and recreational resources and characteristics, connected by Beaver Brook. The properties include Beaver Brook North and the Beaver Brook Historic Reservations. The goal of the project is to initiate invasive plant management and protect and enhance sensitive wetland resource areas, natural communities, cultural resources, and state listed wildlife habitat.

The NOI is anticipated to be filed on January 6, 2021 for the January 21, 2021 Waltham Conservation Commission meeting. The Waltham Conservation Commission is located at 119 School Street in Waltham, MA. Copies of the NOI will be available for review at that location or by contacting the Waltham Conservation Agent. Due to the Commonwealth and City of Waltham's Covid-19 Emergency Response, it is anticipated that paper copies of the Notice of Intent will not be available for inspection.
