The proposed dredging of approximately 50,000 CY of root masses and sediment will be performed by suction type dredging near the dam and a hydraulic auger dredge. The dredged material will be reused on-site on the farm fields.

Written comments on the 401 Water Quality Certification application must be received by Wednesday, October 14, 2020 (21 days of this notice, Public Comments Deadline for Dredging Permit application).

Any group of ten citizens or more, with at least five of the ten residents residing in the municipality(s) in which the license or permitted activity is located, any aggrieved person, or any governmental body or private organization with a mandate to protect the environment who submits written comments may appeal the Department's Certification. Failure to submit written comments before the end of the public comment period may result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing.
