Anticipated date of submission: February 17, 2021

The proposed project is seeking approval to conduct an Ecological Restoration Limited Project off Belchertown Rd (behind #44) in Amherst, MA. The project will create a floodplain along the southern bank of Fearing Brook adjacent to the confluence with the Fort River in order to slow flow and improve water quality. By lowering the southern stream bank and creating a floodplain, stormwater will be able to overtop its banks more frequently, increasing the residence time of surface water for sediment deposition and nutrient assimilation via vegetation. The project will also involve the removal of invasive plant species along the southern bank and replanting with native vegetation for habitat improvement.
