Brief description of project: Ecological restoration limited project on a 1.5-acre pond (latitude 42 44'31" N, longitude 73 10'25" W) located entirely on property owned by William R. and Margot S. Moomaw (Jt. tenants) at 870 Henderson Road, Williamstown MA 01267. The ecological restoration involves the following:

- Hydro-raking (dredging) to remove accumulated biomass, silt and muck, and to restore pond depth during the spring of 2021
- Application of chemical treatment, as needed, for emerging nuisance vegetation, namely bur reed, watershield and Eurasian milfoil with targeted herbicides that act on root systems and are acceptable for public water supplies. The applicant requests approval of a multi-year pond management program that will involve annual assessment and implementation of chemical treatment as needed.

NOI submission date: NOI was submitted to the Conservation Commission, Williamstown MA and the regional office of the MA DEP on January 7, 2021 after notification in Environmental Monitor December 23, 2020. BRP 08 Dredge to be submitted by certified US Mail February 3, 2021.
