Weavers Cove Energy, LLC, is proposing to construct and maintain a liquefied natural gas receiving and storage facility with associated infrastructure, and to conduct maintenance and improvement dredging in the federal navigation channel and a turning basin within Mount Hope Bay, as well as areas associated with the Mill River Western Lateral river crossing.
