

NOTICE OF A REMEDY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN MODIFICATION

Former Oil Terminal Amerada Hess
146-172 Condor Street
East Boston, MA 02108
Release Tracking Numbers 3-4332, 3-17086, 3-23149, and 137460
Tier 1C Permit

A **Remedy Implementation Plan** Modification (310 CMR 40.0874) has been developed for the above site pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.1406). This disposal site was classified as Tier 1C on July 28, 1997 and granted a Waste Site Cleanup Permit on November 14, 1997. A Permit Extension was granted on February 26, 2003.

The **Remedy Implementation Plan** Modification proposes the following measure to respond to a release of oil and or hazardous material at this disposal site:

Excavate and remove soil exceeding Upper Concentration Limits

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of the involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Officer and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or a municipality potentially effected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented pursuant to 310 CMR 10.1405.
