## Receipt of a Request for Determination of Insignificance Under the Interbasin Transfer Act MGL Chapter 21 Section 8b-8d

On April 3, 2002, the Massachusetts Water Resources Commission (WRC) received a request for determination of insignificance under the Interbasin Transfer Act (M.G.L. Chapter 21 §§ 8B-8D) from the Town of Charlton. Charlton is proposing to develop a new water supply system. The source of water will be the existing Oxford Water Company, in the French River basin. Charlton has land area in the French and Quinebaug River basins, so only a portion of the water purchased will constitute an Interbasin Transfer.

Unless additional information is requested, it is expected that the WRC will discuss this request at its May 9, 2002 meeting. A vote to approve or deny the request is anticipated for the June 13, 2002 WRC meeting. These meetings will be held at 1 PM in Conference Room 1102 on the 11th floor of the Environmental Protection Agency Building, One Congress Street, Boston MA.
