Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Bourne Counting House, LLC to license existing changed uses, including 1) providing general health care services, 2) providing care for the elderly and others, 3) a public restaurant, and 4) providing public national park interpretive use space, at 1 Merrill's Wharf, in the municipality of New Bedford in and over filled Tidelands of the New Bedford Harbor, and which is located within a Designated Port Area. The proposed project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Wednesday, May 17 2006, at 11:00 am in the New Bedford Main Public Library (613 Pleasant Street) in New Bedford. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by Friday, June 9, 2006 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
