ANNOUNCEMENT ON "LID SUBDIVISION DEMONSTRATION PROJECT" FOR THE IPSWICH RIVER WATERSHED

As part of a larger project funded by the USEPA Targeted Watersheds Program, the Department of Conservation & Recreation (DCR) will be offering up to \$75,000 to help support a subdivision development project, located in the Ipswich River watershed, to incorporate low-impact development (LID) principles as the basis of its design. 
