

## **NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR TIER I PERMIT EXTENSION**

A release of oil and/or hazardous materials has occurred at this location, which is a disposal site as defined by M.G.L. c. 21E, § 2 and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan, 310 CMR 40.0000. On November 10, 2003, the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) issued a Tier I Permit for Comprehensive Response Actions at the site. On August 17, 2007, Coneco intends to file an Application for a Tier 1 Permit Extension with MassDEP pursuant to 310 CMR 40.0703 and 40.0706. This Application will seek to extend the permit for this site from August 17, 2007 to August 17, 2009 based upon the following rationale:

◆ Conditions at the Site meet the requirements for a Class C-2 Response Action Outcome (RAO). As such, a post-Class C RAO Temporary Solution has been achieved. Continued response actions will be conducted in accordance with 310 CMR 40.0000.
