The Department of Environmental Protection (the "Department" or "DEP") has completed its Administrative Review of the permit application listed above and has determined that the application is administratively complete. Accordingly, the Department will now begin its Technical Review.

Please be advised that this site assignment application has been assigned Report/Transmittal Number W066335, and this report number should be used in all future correspondence regarding this permit application. The Department has determined that the application fulfills the submission requirements as set forth in 310 CMR 16.00, the "Site Assignment Regulations for Solid Waste Facilities" ("Site Regulations").

Upon receipt of this Notice of Administrative Completeness, it is the Applicant's responsibility to comply with the public notice requirements set forth in Section 16.10 (4) of the Site Regulations. The Applicant must provide proof to the Department that the notification requirements of 310 CMR 16.10(4) have been satisfied. Mailing by Certified Mail – Return Receipt Requested is a recommended mechanism for proof of abutter notification.

According to 310 CMR 4.04, the Department would have a total of eighty-one (81) days (21 days Administrative Review and 60 days Technical Review) to issue a final decision to grant or deny the permit. Please be advised that in accordance with the requirements of 310 CMR 16.08(5)(d) 2, the Department will not be able to complete the Technical Review of the application until the Secretary of Environmental Affairs issues the final MEPA certificate on the

project's fulfillment with the MEPA process.

Provided your application is technically adequate, and none of the contingencies outlined in 310 CMR 4.04 occur, the Department will issue a final decision within the timeframes listed above. You will be entitled to a refund of your application fee should the Department fail to complete its final review of your application and make a decision to grant or deny the permit within these timeframes.
