Activity in a 100-year Flood Zone
Installation of Playground Equipment

The Pittsfield Department of Community Development is proposing to undertake the installation of playground equipment at Carrie Bak Park located at the corner of Dewey Avenue and Danforth Avenue in Pittsfield, MA. This proposed activity is located within a 100-year flood zone as indicated on Community Panel Number 250037-0005-C of the National Flood Insurance Program Flood Insurance Rate Map for the City of Pittsfield, Massachusetts, Berkshire County.

The proposed playground installation will be paid for with Community Development Block Grant funds and is estimated to cost approximately \$30,440. The proposed playground installation in the existing park would involve minor disturbance within the 100-year flood plain located at the northwestern corner of the intersection of Dewey and Danforth Streets, Pittsfield, MA. The size of the park is 0.80 acres all of which is located within the 100-year flood plain.
