Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by the City of Beverly to demolish an existing building and construct a new mixed-use building on filled tidelands of Beverly Harbor in the Beverly Designated Port Area in the municipality of Beverly. The proposed project has been determined to be a nonwater-dependent use project. The proponent's consultant is Vine Associates, Inc., 372 Merrimac Street, Newburyport, MA.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Wednesday, December 3, 2008, at 11:00AM at the Beverly City Hall, City Council Chambers, 191 Cabot Street, Beverly. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by December 24, 2008 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
