

On behalf of the Swansea Water District, Prism Environmental, Inc. (Prism) has completed this Environmental Notification Form (ENF) for the addition of a public water supply well to an existing Water Management Act Registration. The well, denoted as Well #12, is located off of Reed Road, adjacent to the Warren Reservoir, in Swansea, Massachusetts. Refer to Figure 1 for the USGS topographic map indicating the property.
Well #12 has been in use since August 5, 2002 under a Water Emergency Declaration and Order (UAO-SE-02-5d002) issued by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MA DEP). Well #12 was approved as a public water supply
identification number is 4292000. Well #12 is approved for a maximum daily withdrawal of 192,960

The proposed site is not listed as an Area of Critical Environmental Concern and is not located in an estimated habitat as indicated on the most recent Estimated Habitat Map of State-Listed Rare Wetland Wildlife published by the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP). New construction consists of the construction of a pump station facility with treatment components, appurtenances, and all other incidental work necessary for a complete and operational facility. Refer to Sheet C-1 for the proposed site plan and Sheet A-1 for the architectural plan, elevations, and details of the proposed pump station.

This project meets the requirements of a limited project in accordance with 310 CMR 10.53(3)(o). The project was designed and will be implemented to minimize impacts to the resource areas and to meet the standards listed in 310 CMR 10.53(3)(o)(2) to the maximum extent practicable. There will be no increase in the volume of water to be pumped from the aquifer. Well #12 will be operated under the Swansea Water District's amended Water Management Act Registration. Compensatory storage is not provided, nor required, since the proposed activities will not change site grades or existing flood storage volume. To minimize adverse impacts during construction, prior to commencing construction activities, temporary siltation and erosion controls (i.e., hay bales and silt fence) will be installed to encompass the area of the proposed activities as indicated on Sheet C-1.
