Description: This filing is a request for approval of a Notice of Project Change (310 CMR 11.10) and for approval of a Phase 1 Waiver (310 CMR 11.11). The project under current MEPA review involves proposed improvements to the George D. Harlow Field (formerly Marshfield Municipal Airport) resulting from the completion of a 20-year Airport Master Plan Update (AMPU). The plan as reviewed proposed the addition of several hangar buildings with a total floor area of 38,800 square feet.

5 Unit T-hangar building = 8,800 square feet 13 Unit T-hangar building = 22,800 square feet 2 conventional hangars (60'x60') = 7,200 square feet

The change is to construct one 106' x 85' conventional hangar instead of two 60' x 60' hangars (see Figures 1 and 2) previously reviewed in the ENF and DEIR. This change increases the total area of hangar space proposed by 1,810 square feet or 4.6% of the hangar floor area previously reviewed. No comments were received specific to the construction of the hangars as a result of the review of the ENF and DEIR. The intent in planning for two smaller hangars was based on the assumption that the hangars would contain one small corporate aircraft each. Due to the need to provide adequate spacing between the proposed and existing hangars, the proposed hangar is to be constructed 70 feet southwest of an existing T-hangar building allowing for a small taxilane between the hangar buildings for the passage of small aircraft (see Figure 2). In order to facilitate this layout it is necessary to consolidate the two smaller hangars for one slightly larger hangar.

The purpose and need for the hangars is explained in detail in Section 2.25, page 2-23 of the
