The North Attleboro National Fish Hatchery has three existing wells that are registered with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts under Massachusetts water withdrawal Registration #42721101. Well #5 was drilled in 2001 in place of the two abandoned wells and ENF was submitted 1/30/2001. Wells 1 & 2 were abandoned due to high concentrations of iron and manganese in the groundwater. Well #4 also has elevated levels of iron and manganese and this well is used for purposes other than fish hatchery consumption. Wells #3 and #5 are being used for hatchery purposes. The hatchery holds a Water Management Act Registration to withdraw an average daily volume of 1.17 Million Gallons Per Day (MGD). The facility utilizes withdrawal volume of approximately 1.0 MGD, which is below its authorized volume.

A new supplemental emergency non-potable water supply well #6 at the North Attleboro National Fish Hatchery is proposed for utilization as a backup source for wells #3 and #5.
